- BUILDING OPENS:** 7:00 a.m.
- INSPECTION:** 7:30 a.m.

- WEIGH IN:** 8:00 a.m.
- COACHES MEETING:** 8:30 a.m.
- WRESTLING BEGINS:** 9:30 a.m.
- BRACKETS:** The brackets will be posted on www.WilliamstonWrestling.com as soon as the information is received from the districts.
- ADMISSION:** \$5.00 (Good for the entire day.)
Competing wrestlers, two coaches, and one manager will be permitted free admission. **No passes will be accepted with the exception of MHSAA-issued passes.**
- PROGRAMS:** Program will be available at the gate early in the morning.
- OFFICIALS:** Charles Barrett, Jim Niemiec, Mitchell Zajac, Randall Kidder
- ENTRIES:** Master Eligibility form and Alpha Master will be forwarded by the District Managers.
- VIDEO:** Taping is permissible by MHSAA regulations. Filmers must supply their own power source. The availability of electrical outlets cannot be assured. Cameras are restricted to the running track above the gym floor.

- COACH:** National Federation Regulations restrict mat-side personnel to two people. This rule will be enforced. We know all coaches are aware of this rule and we respectfully expect compliance.
- WEATHER:** One never knows when inclement weather may strike. We need to be prepared for weather problems. To this end, please contact Tournament Director, Brad Johnson, if you have a weather or delay issue. His cell number is 517-256-0780. The tournament is to be run if 60% of the competitors are present. (Remember that the school-authorized coach must be present for wrestlers to compete.)
- LOCKERS:** We have nine locker rooms. We will assign locker space prior to teams arriving at the tournament. Teams are responsible for the security of their own items. Security cameras are in place and functioning in the hallways outside all locker rooms.
- ACCESS TO GYM:** Only wrestlers, coaches and workers are allowed on the gym floor. Spectators are to stay in the bleachers.
- CONCESSIONS:** The Williamston Wrestling Boosters will offer a full concession stand throughout the tournament day. Breakfast for coaches and wrestlers will be available for purchase after the weigh-in.
- EATING:** Food is restricted to the hallways where the tables will be placed. No food is allowed in the gym or the balcony. We ask that each team accept responsibility for their area throughout the day and at the conclusion of the tournament.
- NO ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO THE TOURNAMENT.**
- MUSIC:** Radios and sound systems are not allowed. Personal-style players are permissible as long as the sound is restricted to the listening of the individual.
- TECHNOLOGY:** We will be running the tournament on the computer system provided by the MHSAA.
- MEDICAL:** We will have a certified athletic trainer on site throughout the tournament.
- MEDIA:** We will automatically contact the following: Detroit News, Detroit Free Press, Lansing State Journal, and the MHSAA. Please provide e-mail, fax, and contact person in an e-mail if you wish to have the results sent to additional outlets.
- HOSPITALITY:** We will provide a hospitality room for coaches, workers and officials during the tournament. Please do not send wrestlers or others into the hospitality room.
- MHSAA REGULATIONS:** Please consult the Participating Team Information on the website for further procedures and regulations.

Williamston High School is honored to have been chosen to be the site of this tournament. We believe we will offer an educationally sound, enjoyable experience for all involved. I invite you to contact me in the event I can be of assistance to you in any way.
